Around 2015, there were plans to sell of land on the Middlemoor HQ complex with the proceeds of the sale to go towards paying the new Exeter Police Station.

The sale fell through and the land as far as I can tell was not sold as well as planning permission refused.

2. How was the new Exeter Police station funded?
